2010 MATCH SCHEDULE

SAT. JUNE 5

SAT. AUGUST 7

Location; Nemaha IA. Four-way stop (M -50 and D-15) 1 mi north to 180th ST, 1.25mi west

Mandatory Safety Meeting---8:45A.M.

Shooting starts at 9:00A.M.

EQUIPMENT: Single shot rifle with exposed hammer of design prior to 1896. Cartridges loaded with black powder, smokeless, duplex loads and a cast or swaged lead bullet. Gas check bullets are allowed. Rifle to conform to N.R.A. rules

SIGHT-IN PERIOD: From \approx 7:00 to 8:45 a.m, a sight-in period will be allowed. Bench rests will be available for use to sight-in on the hanging targets (gongs). No silhouette targets on stands will be shot from the benches. Practice from the standing position will be allowed on all targets.

COURSE OF FIRE: This will be a 40 shot match, ten shots fired at each of the following knock down silhouettes: Chicken (200 yards), Pig (300 yards), Turkey (400 yards), and Ram (500 yards). Chickens must be shot offhand. All other targets may be shot from any position and cross-sticks may be used.

SAFETY: Eye and Ear protection is required for all people on the firing line.

Shooting starts at 9:00A.M.

EQUIPMENT: any 22 caliber rifle, there are 3 classes of rifle: hunter class, silhouette rifle class, and scope class

COURSE OF FIRE: This will be a 40 shot match, ten shots fired at each of the following knock down silhouettes: Chicken (40 yards), Pig (60 yards), Turkey (77 yards), and Ram (100 yards). Prone or standing position. (Subject to change).

SIGHT-IN PERIOD: 7:00am to 8:45am, a sight in period will be allowed.

SAFETY: Eye and Ear protection is required on the line of fire.
