TFL 2011 Buffalo/Cowboy Shoot Rules

2 classes: Muzzleloader, flint or percussion, and cap and ball pistol
Pistol cartridge lever rifle and revolver

Bring a throwing knife or tomahawk for target throwing or use the one provided.

Period clothing required. No carts, no scopes, period containers for weapons and ammunition (saddle bags, pouches, cartridge belts, scabbards, etc.). You may bring your cross sticks or rest for long-range shots. There will be reloading and other skills tested.

Scoring: No timers, a stop watch will be used. Hits score points and your Old West knowledge may be used/tested.

Targets: Steel reactive targets; ranging from 5 yards to 150 yards.

Time: 9:00 AM till afternoon. There will be water and coffee at camp. There will be a break for lunch. A campfire lunch will be provided – beef, beans, biscuits. Bring your own plate, cup, and utensils (old west period correct), or bring your own lunch.

Scenarios: 4 – 6 shoots. Buffalo, long-range animal, long-range pistol, rifle and pistol combos.

Fee: \$10.00 per shooter.

Buffalo Shoot: 10 targets set from 50 to 150 yards. Also 5 man targets set at 25 yards. Five minutes to complete.

Muzzleloaders: 1 shot per target, more points for longer shots. Rifle loaded, but not primed.

Cowboy: 2 shots per target, more points for longer shots; 20 rounds only. Then pistol will be shot.

Long Range Rifle: 10 targets set from 5 yards to 125 yards; 10 rounds only. Muzzleloader may be less.

Long Range Pistol: 5 shots at man-sized target, at 75 yards. May be shot one or two handed.

Rifle & Pistol Combo: Regular Cowboy scenario shoots.
